FOR LATE MAY AND JUNE 2008

The **Council** continued to sponsor a **rosary service** on **Mondays** in **June** for those serving in the **Armed Forces** and for the **sick** and **distressed** of the **Community**. Attendance continues to average between **10** and **15** people with the majority of the attendees from **Council 9282** and the **Ladies Auxiliary**. Those who have participated at least once during the past month from the **Council** and **Ladies Auxiliary** were: Deacon **Fred & Lorine Bourland; Mike & Loretto Walsh; Kathy Walsh, Bob & Maureen Copeskey; Bill Gunter, Lou Pasetto, Kevin Hennessy & Jordan; Brian Thomas, Robert Smith, Steve Molnar, Leon Ring** and **Ernest Bean**. Parishioners who attend regularly include John & Charlene Hoover; Norma Otto, Tina Pooser and Theresa DeLoria.

At last month's business meeting on **June 2** the following items were discussed:

- (1) GK **Jimbo Hash** spoke about his two year tenure as **Grand Knight** and thanked those who had stepped up to serve as chairmen of the various committees. **Jimbo** discussed the importance of fund raising, and diagrammed as to where our annual dues went. He further emphasized the importance of having a good retention committee.
- (2) **Kent Russ** discussed the upcoming gathering at his home on Old Hickory Lake for members of Council 9282 and their family members on Saturday, **June 7**.
- (3) SK **Larry Thompson** announced that his son **Phillip** was now Dr. **Phillip Thompson** as he had just graduated from the **UT-Knoxville school of veterinarian medicine** and having passed state boards was setting up a practice in Dalton, GA. **Phillip** is a third degree member of **Council 9282** and a 4th degree member of **Assembly 1627**.
- (4) SK **Tom Malone** announced that he procured the **Centennial Sportsplex Skating Rink** for the **annual skating party for the handicapped** to be held in **November** the day before Thanksgiving. **Malone** made a motion that the **Council** write a check in the amount of **\$600** which would secure and hold the skating rink for the K of C the night of the skating party. **Paul Taylor** seconded the motion and after a short discussion the motion was **voted upon and carried unanimously**.

(5) Discussion of **MR funds** occurred and it was noted that the **Council** had over **\$2000** in this account which had to be spent before the end of the Fraternal Year (June 30). A motion was made by **Mike Porter** and seconded by **Bill Gunter** that the **Council** expend **\$1000** to the “**Empower Me Day Camp**” of **Wilson County** for the mentally handicapped. After discussion the motion was voted upon and carried unanimously. Another **motion** was made by **Larry Thompson** and seconded by **Bob Copeskey** that **\$1000** be sent to the **Mental Health Association of Middle Tennessee (MHAMT)** for their many projects as we have done in previous years. After a short discussion the motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

(6) **GK Hash** announced that the Council needed a chairman to run the Tootsie Roll Drive this fall. **Paul Taylor** volunteered to run the Drive for another year.

(7) At this point the regular business meeting was interrupted for the business of **selecting, nominating and voting** in the new officers for the **Fraternal Year 2008-09**. **A list of the new officers may be found elsewhere in this newsletter.**
