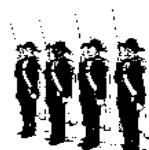

The 40 Days for Life Prayer Campaign in Nashville ended on November 1st. Beginning September 23rd, for 40 days, we provided a continual, 12-hours-a-day public witness of faith in front of the Women's Center on Welshwood Drive, an abortion facility in Nashville. We prayed for an end to abortion at this place and a conversion of the hearts and minds of the people that work there. Several of the clinic employees have indicated they would now prefer to work elsewhere and shared their resumés with us. We've made a genuine impact on their lives, and are helping them seek work in more life-affirming opportunities.

For 40 days, we prayed and held silent vigils. On the last day, at the last hour, we broke into loud song and praise by candlelight. We are hoping, like the walls of Jericho, that the walls of this building will come tumbling down and we need not return next year. But if we have to be there again, we hope to see you there, too, to share in the prayer and the victories.

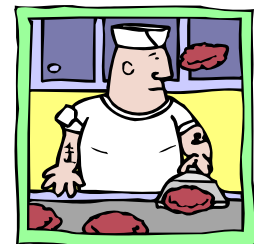
